TALENTED's overall goal is to contribute to autistic adults' employability and social inclusion by bringing qualitative improvements in the existing adult training offer.

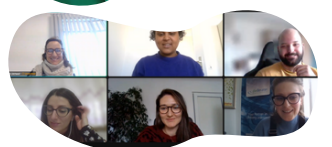


Transnational Research Report

The first research phase of the project is now completed. Our comprehensive findings from the desk and field research we conducted in 7 countries can be found in an executive summary, available in 8 languages. It provides an overview of the employment situation for autistic individuals in various EU countries: Bulgaria, Estonia, Greece, Germany, Lithuania, Spain, and Portugal.
